Frank Leibfarth is an Associate Professor in the Department of Chemistry who was named to the 2021 "Brilliant 10" by Popular Science magazine which highlights early-career scientists and engineers solving challenging problems of societal need. He formed The Leibfarth Group @ UNC that provides students with a diverse and competitive skill set to dig deeper into material science and biotechnology. This group has worked with UNC Wonder Connection to expand the curricula for children undergoing long-term hospitalization at UNC. Using fun activities, children in UNC Hospital School are able to dig into the physical sciences, with a particular focus in polymer science. Leibfarth and a few members of his team will join us to showcase their transformational work and how it is supporting the campus and neighboring communities.
